Marcelo Copello Sangiovese 90%, Merlot 5%, Cabernet Sauvignon 5%, aged for 12 months, partly in cement and partly in large Slavonian oak barrels. Deep ruby red color with garnet hues. Aromas of fresh red fruit, spices, cherry, blackberry, and licorice. On the palate, the wine exhibits bright acidity and well-structured tannins, leaving a pleasantly dry finish.

Robert Parker Wine Advocate Here's an "annata" expression with a medium dark color and extra concentration. The Tenuta Casenuove 2018 Chianti Classico is 90% Sangiovese with 8% Merlot and 2% Cabernet Sauvignon aged in large oak casks. Production this year is 45,000 bottles. The wine reveals plenty of ripe fruit, blackberry and plum, with background notes of grilled rosemary and blue flower. The wine shows medium fruit weight and a smooth texture.

Falstaff Trophy 2021 Bright ruby red color with brownish shades. A bouquet of ripe black cherries, slightly floral, violet and licorice, with a hint of cocoa beans and pepper. Fresh, good acidity accompanied by well-integrated tannins, long finish, finesse and elegance.

With small percentages of Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon in this otherwise Sangiovese-based wine, the Tenuta Casenuove 2019 Chianti Classico flaunts bright cherry and bold fruit definition. It is intermingled with wild bramble that reflects the landscape of Panzano in Chianti with its pretty mix of vineyards and forests. Hints of smoke and scorched earth fill in the rear. Production is 59,500 bottles, hitting the market now.

Tony Wood Pale purple in colour. Dark blue florals. Red cherry, wild strawberry, crushed raspberry, damp forest floor, pomegranate. Secondary notes of clove and mint. Graphite minerality. Medium bodied. Dusty tannins and zingy acidity. Slight dry tension coming to the mouthfeel after the finish.

Jeb Dunnuck T Coming from Panzano, the 2020 Chianti Classico is a potent entry in this portfolio, offering up layers of black cherry compote, crushed purple flowers, and eucalyptus, with its initial volatile aromas blowing off after a few minutes in the glass. Full-bodied and meaty, with ripe tannins and dark mineral carth, it is impressive and balanced, with fleshy ripe fruit that is well concentrated and weightless throughout. Drink 2024-2036.

The 2021 was vinified in cement, while aging was done in equal parts cement and cask.

Antonio Galloni Vinous The 2022 Chianti Classico is a rich, heady wine. Dark cherry, plum, rose petal, lavender and spice are all dialed up. This is a decidedly exuberant style, but it works quite well. Silky and supple, the 2022 is an incredibly classy and polished wine. Floral notes lift the long, sustained finish. This is one of the better wines in its peer group.

Jancis Robinson Panzano. 95% Sangiovese, 5% Canaiolo. Certified organic. Deep, lustrous ruby. Firm, tingling, peppery nose with brooding fruit and a little bloody. Opens very slowly. Emerging complexity. Real concentration yet suave and polished. Cherry and raspberry charged with juicy acidity and tasty, chewy tannins. Real energy. Complete. (Walter Speller)14.5%
